

SFE Show Prize List October 13th

General Information

Every class offered is governed by the rules of Equine Canada and will be judged accordingly. Competitors of the riding phases must be a member of the Ontario Equestrian Federation. If entries warrant classes will be split into Adult Armature, Open and Junior.

Closing date- For dressage, short course, combined training Wednesday October 10thth is the closing date. Entries for dressage & combined training received after the closing date or without payment by this date will not be entered into the show. Monday 8th is the deadline to get entries in for all events and NOT have to pay late fee. All classes except dressage, short course and combined training may enter the day of the show.

Cancellations accompanied by a vet certificate will be accepted with a full refund less administration fee post-closing date and pre-show date. Cancellations on show day for any reason and no shows will be charged the full amount.

schooling entries will be accepted. These will be subject to the same judging conditions as a regular entry and must pay the posted entry fee. Schooling entries are NOT eligible for ribbons or awards but will be scored.

Speed class. 4 seconds added per rail & refusal.

Table A

Rider must go clear, if they do, they will ride a second round, which is timed. 4 Seconds added per rail or refusal.

Medal

Riders ride a judged round. The top 4 horses are called back for a flat class.

Power & Speed

The first 4-5 jumps riders must go clear, if they do, they will continue with the timed 4-5 jumps. 4 Seconds added per rail or refusal.

Equitation Over Fences

Riders will ride over a course being judged on the correctness of their position and rider ability.

Hunter Over Fences

Riders will ride over a course being judged on the correctness of their horse.

Equitation Under Saddle

Riders will all ride at the same time in the ring, following instruction of the scribe. Riders may be asked to walk, trot, canter, ride with and without stirrups, sit, post or two-point.

In the case of lead line, riders will be not be asked to canter and minimal trot.

Leadline

Riders will be asked to walk and halt. Game to be posted the day of the show.

Combined Training

A division with a dressage test and a show jumping round. 1st place goes to the rider with the lowest combined score of both rounds.

Short Course

A division with a dressage test and a combined stadium jumping and cross country round. 1st place goes to the rider with the lowest combined score of both rounds.

Stall Rental

There are a limited number of stalls up for rent. Please, rent your stall in advance. \$25/ day including shavings.

Dog Policy

Dogs are permitted, but must be leashed.

Ride Times

Ride times for dressage & Combined training, will be posted 2-3 days before the show date. All other classes will run in order of class list. www.silverfoxequine.com
